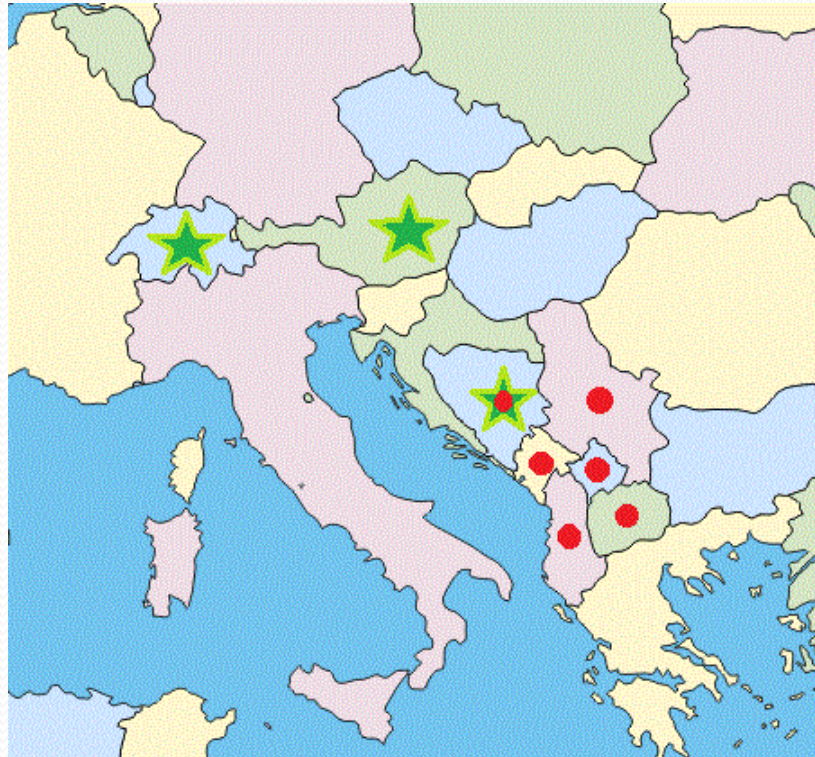

UNEP ROE is working in the region on its 6 priority areas:

various levels, and actively engage in and facilitate the ongoing
dialogue between the civil society, the private sector and

- Green economy sectoral modeling studies (completed or ongoing) - Scenario analysis to illustrate how selected green policy changes and investment will improve a country's sustainability outlook compared to business as usual and to quantify potential benefits
